2. GROOMS

The OC will not be responsible for any travelling or living expenses. A sufficient number of WCs and hot-water showers will be available. Any grooms wishing to remain within the FEI stable area during the night may do so only with the authorization of the Chief Steward.

3. HORSES

The OC will not be responsible for any travelling or feeding expense. Horses must be stabled in the boxes assigned to them on the show ground. Horses may not be unloaded on their arrival without the authorization of the Stable Manager.

Stables will be allocated on arrival but PLEASE MAKE SPECIAL REQUESTS (e.g. stallions) with definite entries. Stables must be mucked out daily and dirty bedding and rubbish placed in the special containers. All horses will be bedded on straw unless specifically requested with entries.

Further supplies will be provided daily according to instructions & prices available on arrival. Horses must be stabled within the FEI stable area for the duration of the event. The stables will be closed between 11,00 pm and 6,30 am. No horses may leave the stable area

4. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ENTRY OF HORSES

All participating horses must be in possession of:

- A declaration (with detailed list) from their own NF stating that the same is temporally imported into Italy to take part in the CSI Tortona

All horses from EEC countries taking part in the same show must possess the official veterinary health certificates approved by the EEC Board of Directors 90/422/6 dated 26.06.1990, and subsequent amendment EEC 92/130 dated 13.02.1992

From 2007 it is obligatory for all horses based and travelling around Italy to result negative to the serum test of E.I.A. (Equine Infectious Anaemia). All foreign riders are Strongly Advised to produce the same negative test on the official documents of their horses.

THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. **The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.**

IMPORTANT

The value of the 1st prize must not exceed 1/3 of the total prize money distributed for the competition. The minimum number of prizes offered for each competition must be allocated on the basis of one prize for every commenced four Athletes, with a minimum of five prizes. The total amount of prize money shown for each Competition in the schedule must be distributed. (GR Art 127, 128)

The retail value of all prizes in kind must be mentioned as well as detail of model, type and special features for cars.

Instructions for breakdown of prize money:

- No more than 1/3 of the total prize money for the competition to the winner.
- Break down for 1st to 8th place (at least) in a reasonable descending order of distribution must be listed in the Schedule.
- The minimum amount the last placed competitor receives must be indicated in the Schedule.
- Minimum 25% of competitors must receive prize money (one prize for every four starters), however minimum 5 prizes if there are 20 or fewer athletes taking part in the competition.
- The FEI has the right to alter the amounts proposed for distribution if the necessity arises.
